He spent his early years being trained as the ultimate Commie secret agent, and then was brainwashed to forget his Commie ties and take his place in Alpha Complex's Armed Forces. He served better than expected, and with his move to the troubleshooters and quick promotion to ORANGE, his Commie masters have decided to activate him. Apoll-O now has his full memories back, and is ready to serve. He feels a little guilty though, because the Army has been so much fun, but he knows his loyalty to the Party comes first.

To help him in his efforts, Apoll-O has two very useful mutant powers. His minor one is Telekinesis. It's not very strong at all, but Apoll has practiced extensively with it and is quite adept at manipulating very small items. The other power is his Machine Empathy. This one is extremely powerful, and Apoll-O tries to keep a lid on it as much as possible, because he knows the Computer hates Machine Empathy over all other mutant abilities and watches for signs of it all the time.

Talents: Apoll-O is moderately proficient with pistols and hand-to-hand combat. He has a fair knowledge of Communist propaganda, and he's not bad at scaring subordinates into action.

Black laser pistol—(standard firearm)

4 Orange laser barrels—(barrels screw onto pistol or rifle and have 8 shots each)

Orange Reflec armor—(protects against Red or Orange laser fire)

Orange jumpsuit uniform—(standard troubleshooter uniform with many pockets)

Black utility belt—(with loops and pockets for carrying things)

Red Flashlight—(useful for seeing in the dark)

Red Comm Unit—(basic radio communication; short range and only three channels)

Orange notepad—(for writing things down)

Black mechanical pencil—(figure it out)

Orange Kevlar vest—(for stopping bullets and such)

8 pamphlets entitled "The Glorious Revolution and You—how Communism can Work for You"

4 Orange Smoke grenades

Orange knit cap

Black boots

1 pamphlet on "Surviving Inclement Weather"

1 plain unlabeled can

2 small bots (at about three inches long, they are a dark gray and covered with some sort of artificial hair; they have two eyes at one end, with largish round ears mounted above, plus a couple of inches of tail hanging off the back; each bot has a single clearly marked on/off switch on the underside)

Orange can (like a Pringles can) labeled "Thermal suit—Wonderland—Large"

8 grenades

A lighter

2 tubes that look like superglue

Bottle with 9 Red pills

From R&D: enchanted Anti-Personnel Mini Projectile Launcher (a four foot tall longbow) plus a quiver of arrows described as: 20 standard projectiles plus 6 special purpose missiles (reveals the quiver holds 20 black ones and 6 Orange ones. The Orange ones are labeled EX, G-S, G-C, G-P, AP-G, and D-F.)
